### **New LAVA Esthetic** (Monolithic) Crown





D&S is proud to offer the latest monolithic zirconia to hit the marketplace. It's called Lava Esthetic and it is manufactured by 3M. In our zirconia world at D&S, our main high translucency zirconia is ZR Plus at 1,100 mPA, then we have the super translucent zirconias, which include Imagine<sup>™</sup> (769 mPA) and the new Lava Esthetic (800 mPA).

Lava Esthetic is a little stronger and slightly more translucent than Imagine™, but it currently only comes in eight shades: Bleach, A1, A2, A3, A3.5, B1, C1 and D2. Of the monolithic zirconias, it is the most translucent at the incisal and is described as the first zirconia with inherent toothlike fluorescence. Similar to Imagine™, you can only do threeunit bridges with Lava Esthetic.

Write "Lava Esthetic" on your next RX form to give it a try.

### TECHNICIAN'S TIP OF THE MONTH

Lack of occlusal clearance is one of the most common issues we run into at the laboratory. There is a slick new prep-marking product on the market called PrepCheck™, which will help make sure you have enough space for the desired restoration.

Here's how it works. You insert a small tab between the preparation and opposing dentition. If the tab doesn't slide out with little resistance, you insert the coated side and have the patient tap or grind down on it. The tab has a special coating that marks the teeth, showing you the areas that need to be reduced.
